With winter fast approaching thought that we would remind you of our inclement weather policy. Loudoun County Public Schools are closed, Celebration Preschool is closed. If LCPS delays the opening of school by one hour, Celebration Preschool will delay the AM session one hour. School will start at 9:45 AM and dismiss at 11:45 AM (Caterpillars, <u>Bumblebee</u>s, Butterflies Dragonflies). The Fireflies will be dismissed at 2:00 PM. The PM session will start on time. If LCPS delays the opening of school by two hours the AM session will begin at 10:45 AM and will be dismissed one hour later at 12:45 PM (Caterpillars, Bumblebees, Butterflies & AM Dragonflies). The Fireflies will be dismissed at 2:00 PM. The PM session will begin one hour later at 1:30 PM and dismiss on time at 3:30 PM.

With that in mind please remember to send in coats, mittens/gloves, hats, and scarves. Please make sure that your child's coat is labeled. If you have not brought in a change of winter clothing for you child, please do so as soon as possible.



Chapel will be held on Wednesday, December 11<sup>th</sup> at 9:15 AM for the W/F Caterpillars, Bumblebees, M/W/F BF and AM DF and at 1:00 PM for the PM DF. The T/TH Caterpillars, T/TH BF and Fireflies will attend chapel on Thursday, December 12<sup>th</sup> at 9:15 AM.
